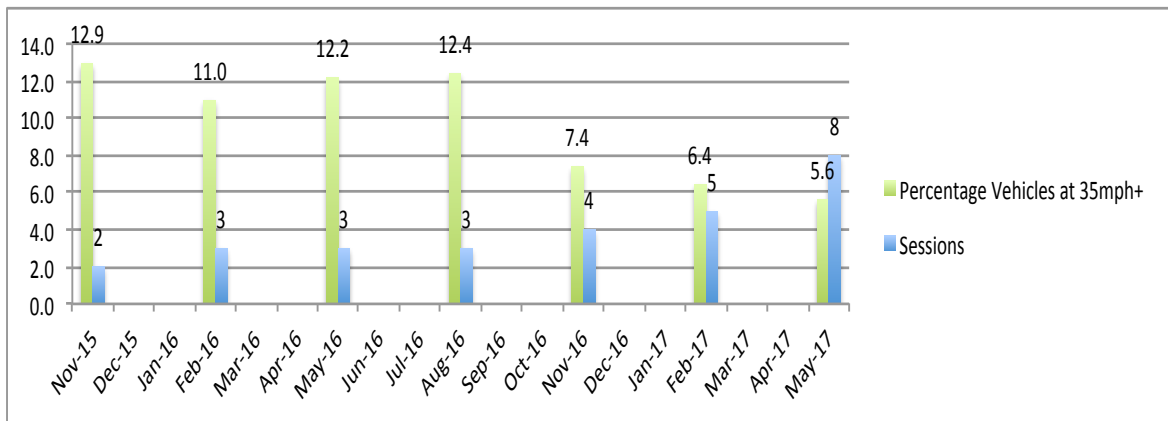
Kingsley Community Speedwatch.

Speeding vehicles through Kingsley appears to be reducing.

The Kingsley team was out in force in May and managed to complete 8 sessions with the Speed Indicator Device; the most we have done for sometime. So a big thanks is due to the other 5 volunteers that made this possible.

Over the 8 sessions, we counted 1614 vehicles going by the SID with 91 recorded at or above 35mph. That is 5.6% of the total number of vehicles counted.

The author has been able to go back through past data to see how this compares with previous times.



Kingsley gets the SID once every 3 months and the data above covers the seven individual months of use going back to November 2015. The green columns show the overall percentage of speeding vehicles for each month of use. The blue columns represent the number of sessions completed each month. It appears to show that the number of speeders through the village is reducing and that this could be linked to the number of sessions we do. Or put another way, the more times we are out, the more aware drivers are that they need to keep to the speed limit through our village. It is anticipated that we will have two more volunteers by August (when we next get the SID); but we could always do with more. The more volunteers we have, the more sessions can be scheduled and the fewer speeders there will be in our village.
