**Invitation to attend a stakeholder preview ahead of a public exhibition for Kingsley Quarry, Hampshire**

I am writing on behalf of Tarmac to invite you to attend a stakeholder preview ahead of a public exhibition we are holding to display proposals for the future of Kingsley Quarry.

Kingsley Quarry is a sand quarry in east Hampshire, which has been in operation since 1966. The most recent quarry extension was granted in 1990. However, the existing reserves will be exhausted in the next 12 to 18 months and so we are preparing a planning application to secure the future of the operation.

The planning application will seek permission to:

- Extend the quarry extraction area into a 3.4ha site to the east of the existing operation (location plan enclosed);
- Extend the end date for operations at the site until 2028, with an additional year to complete restoration; and
- Amend the restoration scheme for the existing site to include a larger lake, as well agricultural land on the site to the north of the B3004.

The planning application does not propose to alter the method or rate of extraction, the processing activities, the operating hours, or the permitted level of road movements to and from the site. It will provide a major contribution towards meeting the local demand for high quality silica sand, which is a unique resource used in the horticulture, sports and leisure sectors.

Whilst the proposed extension area is still outside of the National Park boundary, we recognise the sensitivity of the area and are aware that residents will have views. We are therefore holding a public exhibition next month to give people the opportunity to view our proposals, meet the project team and submit their feedback. The details of the event are as follows:

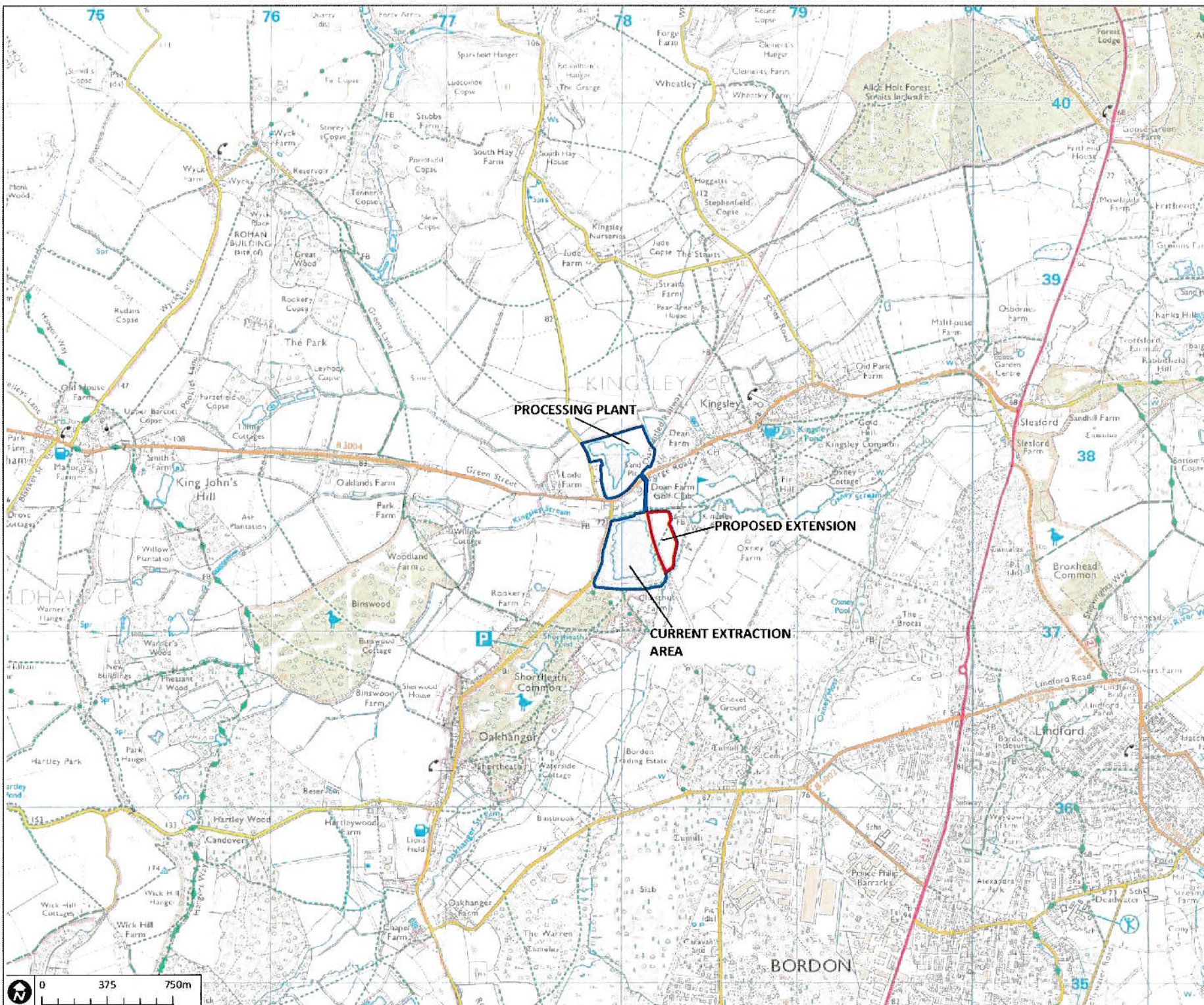

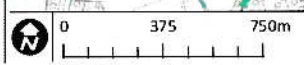
