Dear All,

Please be aware of the following incidents that have occurred or been reported during the period 09/03/17 – 17/03/17.

Blacknest

Between 1830 on 08/03 and 0730 on 09/03 unknown person(s) have driven at compound fence causing damage at Blacknest Industrial Park. Nothing has been stolen.

Between 2300 on 15/03 and 0730 on 16/03 on 16/03 entry has been forced to a double garage in Binsted Road and removed a hedge-trimmer, chain saw and leaf blower. A passenger window has also been smashed and a chainsaw removed from the footwell.

Four Marks

Between 1900 on 08/03 and 1000 on 09/03 a shed in Windmill Fields has been broken into and tools stolen.

Bentley

Between 1730 on 08/03 and 0730 on 09/03 entry has been gained to a building site at Hole Lane and machinery valued at over £3000 stolen.

East Tisted

Between 1700 on 10/03 and 0850 on 11/03 entry has been gained to a garage/lockup on farm estate at Rotherfield Park and a double axle trailer stolen.

Alton

Between 1100 on 11/03 and 1145 on 12/03 wing mirror mechanism has been taken from a vehicle parked at Spencer Close leaving wipers hanging off and a stick also put into the exhaust.

Between 1200 on 06/03 and 1600 on 13/03 a shed in Old Odiham Road has been broken into and tools stolen from within.

Between 1130 on 14/03 and 1100 on 15/03 entry has been gained to a restaurant in the High Street via an insecure toilet window and stolen a CCTV box.

Between 0001 and 1149 on 15/03 the rear door of Kebab Fast Food Shop in High Street has been forced to gain entry and cash stolen from the till along with CCTV recording box.

Between 2015 and 2115 on 15/03 a mini dumper truck has been moved from Mill Lane and driven down path towards Upper Neatham Mill before getting stuck and abandoned. Offenders left a white transit van.

Between 1500 on 15/03 and 0900 on 16/03 the reinforced glass to two front doors of property have been broken at commercial premises in Mill Lane.

Bentworth

Between 1630 and 1800 on 12/03 a Stihl pruning saw has been stolen from boundary of property in Holt End Lane.

Bucks Horn Oak

Between 2340 on 10/03 and 0040 on 11/03, wheel trims have been stolen from a vehicle which was at the back of Gulf Petrol Station in Main Road.

Oakhanger

Between 0745 and 0750 on 16/03 a petrol chain saw has been stolen from the back of a van which was parked with the back doors open in Oakhanger Road.
