Dear All,

Please be aware of the following incidents that have occurred or been reported during the period 16/02/17 – 23/02/17.

Four Marks

Between 1545 on 15/02 and 0610 on 16/02 a One Tone Dumper Truck has been stolen from a building site at The Shrave.

Between 1900 on 14/02 and 0800 on 15/02 a gate has been pulled off a wall in Winston Rise.

Between 1130 and 1315 on 17/02 entry has been gained to a property at The Shrave by forcing the front door. A safe has been ripped from a wall, car keys taken from the address and a vehicle stolen.

Between 1200 on 16/02 and 1400 on 17/02 a Trek Fuel Ex 9 cycle valued at £3000 has been stolen from a garage with door left open for access for vehicle to be driven into, in Hawthorn Road.

Between 14/02 and 20/02 an unknown offender has broken into a shed in Telegraph Lane and stolen a generator.

At 1800 on 16/02 a male was seen using spray paint on a bus shelter in Chawton Park Road, he was wearing a mask and carrying a bag.

Between 1830 on 12/02 and 0830 on 13/02 a wing mirror of a vehicle parked on Westbrooke Road has been damaged.

Between 1600 on 16/02 and 1545 on 17/02 a 3 tonne breakpoint plant has been stolen from construction site in Mill Lane.

Between 1730 on 16/02 and 0930 on 18/02 a garage in Whitedown has been forced and entry gained. Nothing has been stolen.

Between 1700 and 1720 on 20/02 the rear windscreen of a vehicle parked in

Turk Street has been smashed.

Between 1900 on 16/02 and 0700 on 17/02 entry has been gained to a secure barn in Forge Road and a number of pieces of farm machinery stolen.

Between 2330 and 2335 on 20/02, 4 x suspects in a vehicle have entered land in London Road and opened up storage containers containing garden machinery. It is also believed that intention was to steal dogs from kennels in rear yard. Nothing was taken as suspects were disturbed but a dog was run over and injured as suspects left the yard.
