Dear All,

Please be aware of the following incidents that have occurred or been reported during the period 17/10 – 26/10/16.

### **Selborne**

Between 0430 to 0515 on 16/10 entry has been gained to 2 wooden sheds in Selborne Hill and items stolen from within.

### **Kingsley**

Between 1700 on 17/10 and 0800 on 18/10 access has been gained to a property in Forge Road and items stolen from within.

Between 1515 and 1630 on 18/10 a workshop in Forge Road has been broken into and a quad bike and tools stolen.

Between 1638 on 25/10 and 0735 on 26/10 building materials have been stolen from the driveway of a property.

### **Alton**

Between 1700 on 17/10 and 0700 on 18/10 a rear near side wheel of vehicle parked in Anstey Road has been stolen.

It was reported at 1450 on 18/10 an attempt has been made to break into a property in Eggars Close, there were visible marks on the front door but no access gained.

Between 1800 on 18/10 and 0815 on 19/10 a window has been smashed and a disused brewery broken into in Turk Street. Although a length of stainless steel pipe has been dragged across the factory floor, it was too large to fit through the window to remove.

At 1307 on 19/10 an owner has returned to an unoccupied restaurant in Amery Street believing person(s) were inside. There were signs of forced entry and 2 males located inside.

It was reported at 0423 on 22/10 that a window had been smashed to main entrance in block of flats at Saxon House in Drayman's Way.

Between 1530 on 25/10 and 0840 on 26/10 unknown offenders have smashed the rear office door to store in High Street, smashed open the safe and stolen £427.25 in various denominations.
