Dear All,

Please be aware of the following incidents that have occurred or been reported during the period 27/01 – 05/02/17.

Alton,

Between 2000 on 28/01 and 0830 on 29/01 all 4 tyres of a vehicle parked at Helens Close have been slashed.

Between 1750 and 1800 on 28/01, 2 x “No Parking” signs have been stolen from the front gates of property in Eastbrooke Road.

Between 1200 on 28/01 and 0945 on 29/01 the nearside of a vehicle parked at Butts Road has been damaged.

Between 1200 on 28/01 and 0945 on 29/01 a vehicle on Butts Road has been keyed on both doors on the rear passenger side.

Holt Pound,

Between 1800 on 29/01 and 0700 on 30/01, a mobile construction site in Farnham Road has been broken into and machinery engines started but not moved. Entry has been forced to a storage container and machinery stolen.

Lower Farringdon,

Between 2150 on 30/01 and 2000 on 31/01 entry has been gained via a steel roof of building to Alton Rifle Club in Brightstone Lane. A quantity of lead has been stolen.

Selborne

Between 2100 and 2200 on 01/02 a mini Kubota excavator has been stolen from a residential premises in Fountain Road.

Four Marks

Between 0930 and 1200 on 03/02, two locks on stable door have been smashed to gain entry to stable where machinery is stored at property in Lymington Bottom Road and a petrol chainsaw stolen.
